

# Green Star Award Guidelines

**For: Junior Cadets**

**Awarded at the club level**



## General Requirements

---

1. Junior Cadets should not be encouraged to work for the Green Star award, but rather this award should have an incentive aim: that the recipient will be motivated to a fuller and more enthusiastic participation in cadeting and will become an example to other Junior Cadets.
2. Nominees for this award must have been an active Junior Cadet for a minimum of one Cadet season.
3. Nominees for this award must have a good understanding of the Junior Cadet program.
4. Nominees should exhibit leadership potential and show that they are trying to live up to the standards established by the Junior Cadet landmarks.
5. In order for a Junior Cadet to qualify for this award, an outstanding effort is required in one or more of the areas listed in the guidelines, or a superior accomplishment in a significant area not listed.

## Guidelines

---

1. Meets all the general requirements established for the Green Star award.
2. Displays enthusiasm for the Junior Cadet program and activities, and takes part in club and council events whenever possible.
3. Outstanding achievement in one or more of the following areas ...
  - a. Ranks and merit badges earned
  - b. Knowledge and practices of Junior Cadet landmarks
  - c. Cadre leadership
  - d. Overcoming handicaps (physical or other)
4. Nominations are to be made to the head counselor by the boy's cadre counselor. Selections are to be made by a 2/3 decision of all the counselors and junior counselors of the club. Awards are to be made by the club at an official club event of the Junior Cadet season. We recommend that this includes parents.
